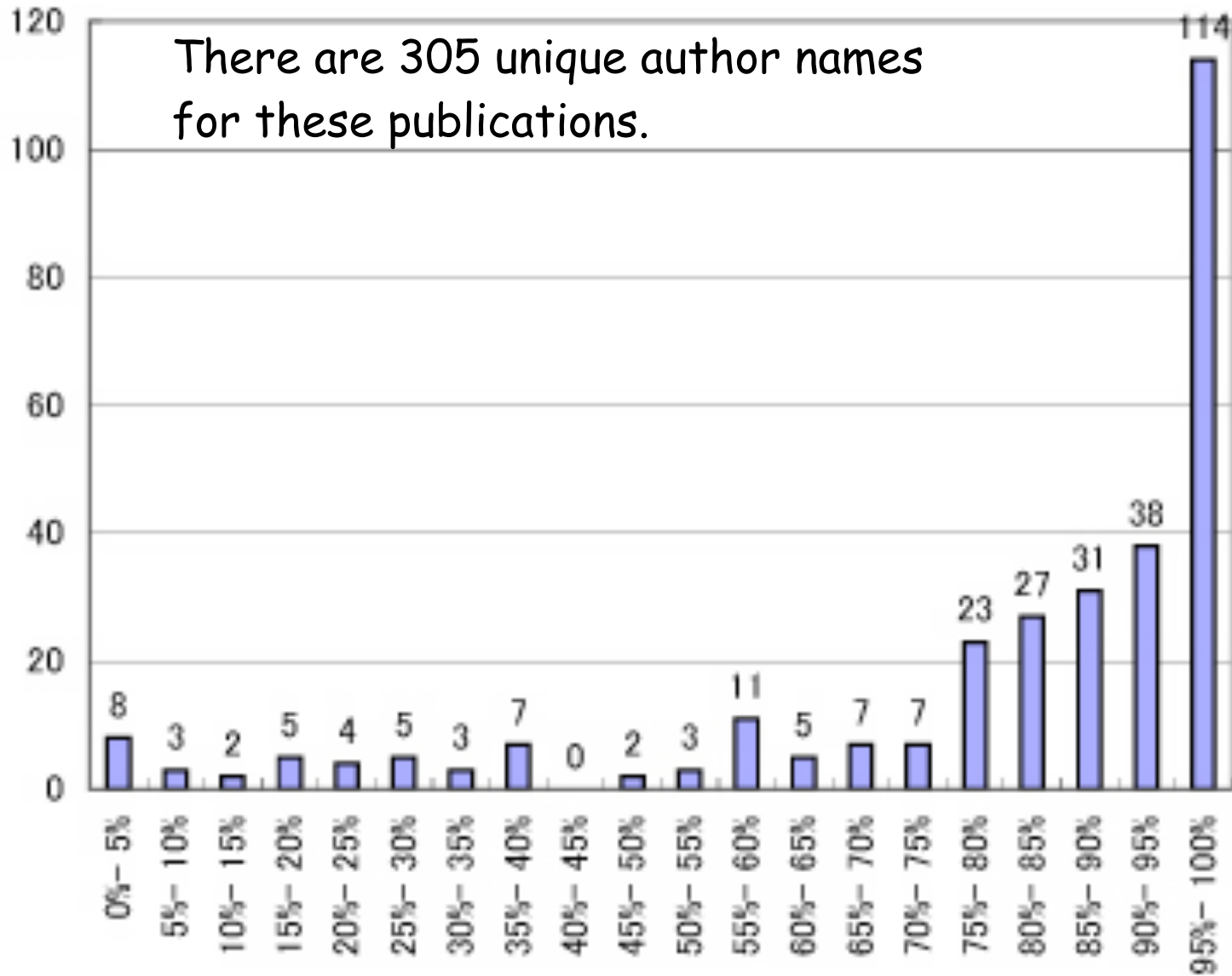
What is the distribution of the number of papers signed by individual members of the Belle Collaboration?

For the early period when this sign-up procedure was first introduced and more recently?

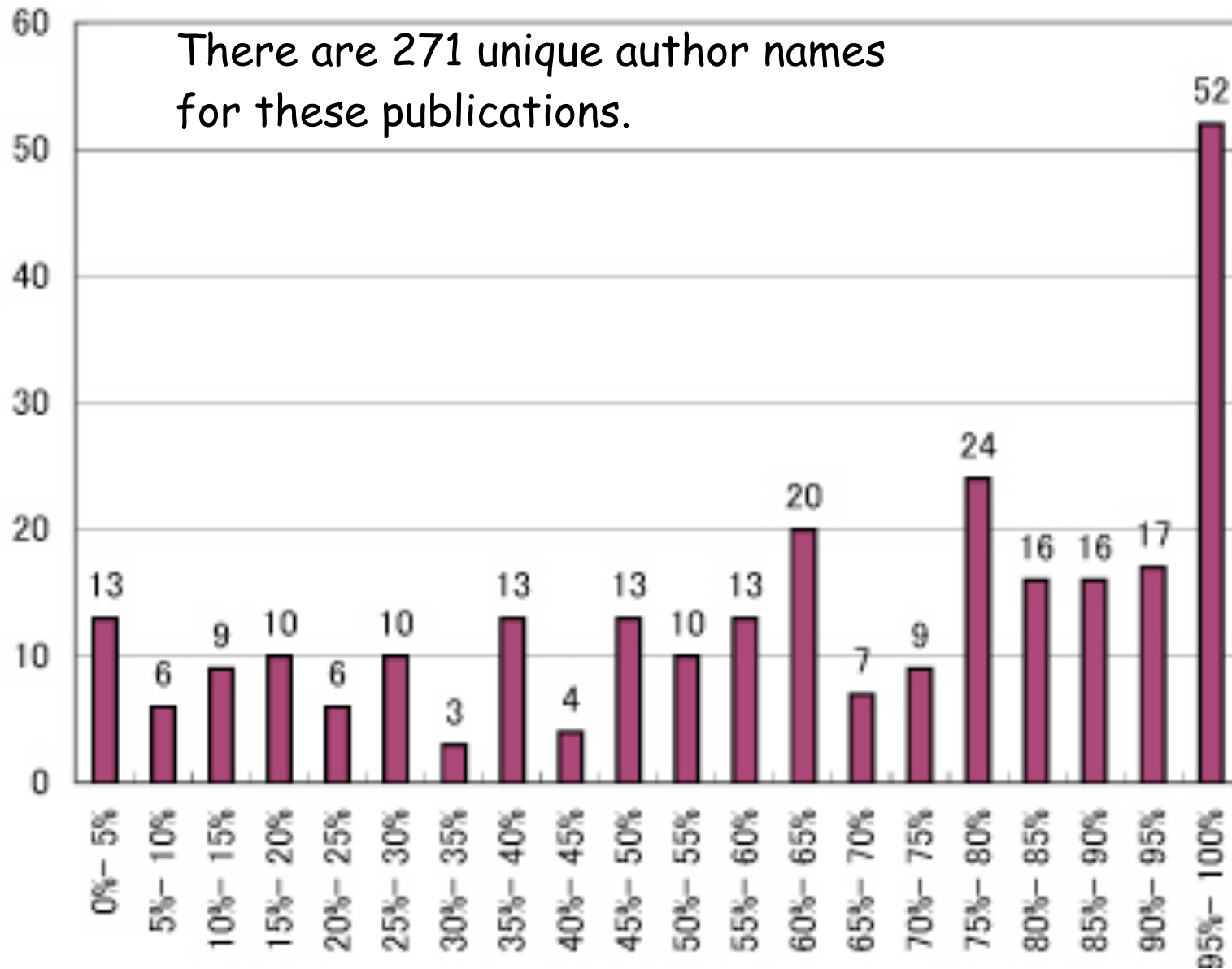
First 25 publications
